

TO THE HONOURABLE THE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ASSEMBLED IN PARLIAMENT

We, the undersigned Citizens of Victoria, call on the Legislative Council of Victoria to note:

- Rather than providing a grade separated solution to its proposed removal of the Eel Race Road level crossing, and unlike has occurred with the Level Crossing Removal Program across metropolitan Melbourne, the Andrews Labor Government is intending instead to close the existing Eel Race Road level crossing, putting to great inconvenience and heightened risk local traffic that currently uses this level crossing to access the Nepean Highway.
- Closing the Eel Race Road level crossing leaves reduced access into Seaford from the Nepean highway. By closing the crossing, it will divert traffic to the extremely dangerous Armstrongs Road crossing, where there has been two fatalities in the past few months and which the Andrews Labor Government does not intend to remove despite its clear and present danger to motorists, cyclists and pedestrians, in comparison to Eel Race Road which has experienced with no fatalities since 1973.

We therefore call upon the Andrews Labor Government to rethink its approach and reverse its decision to close Eel Race Road level crossing.
